Sioux Empire 4-H Rodeo Rules & Information

In accordance with South Dakota law 12:68:12:08; the Sioux Empire Fair will be requiring health papers for the Sioux Empire 4-H Rodeo.

Attention:

The Fairgrounds will be charging a \$10 gate fee per person if you do not arrive before 8:00am the day of the rodeo!

1. Entries must be postmarked by July 19, 2021.

Incomplete entries will be returned. There will be no entries allowed at registration. No refunds.

2. State 4-H Rodeo Rules will be used.

- Vests and mouthpieces are required to be worn for rough stock events
- Contestants must wear their number at all times.
- Hat rule will be enforced.
- 3. There will be no exhibition runs.
- **4.** Contestants will be called twice before moving to the next contestant unless contestant is obligated in other arena. Small arena takes precedence.
- **5.** All grievances must be directed toward the Arena Director. Harassment of Rodeo Officials by contestant or representative of contestant will result in disqualification of contestant.
- **6.** Ties will be broken by coin toss.
- **7.** Contestant must provide own hazer or calf pusher.
- **8.** Event order is subject to change.
