**Any harassment by parents or contestants to judges, office staff, rodeo volunteers, or other rodeo participants will result in disqualification of contestant.

**Horses may be stalled in make shift pens or by trailers but pens must be torn down by 8:00 am on Saturday - this will be enforced.

**Ambassador Contest: Interviews will take place Friday morning beginning at 10:00 am. Meet at Office. Horsemanship will be Saturday morning at 8:30 am SHARP. Coordinator is Cheryl Schmitt cell (605)830-1457.

**Buckles for 1st place, Ambassador, and All Around for each day. The 10 point system will be used to determine all around. Prizes will also be awarded to 2-4th place and reserve all around.

State 4H rules will be used. We encourage you to obtain and use the State 4H Rodeo Rules and Regulations SH-91 at your local County Extension Office. Some new rules have been added and it is the contestant's responsibility to learn the new rules.

Contestants will be called for twice before they will be passed by. Be ready, unless obligated in the other arena.

State Finals Rodeo Entry:

State Finals paper work entry deadline is May 1st. Contestants are responsible to read and follow the General Information on the Finals Entry Forms and the Ground Rules pertaining to the 4H Finals Rodeo. All contestants qualifying for the 4H Finals Rodeo (by finishing in the top 4 places at a Regional/County 4H rodeo) are automatically entered. If a contestant does not wish to enter the finals or has event/events that they wish to not enter, then they will have to notify the Finals Secretary by emailing sd4hfinals@hotmail.com by August 8th. If the contestant does not notify the secretary prior to the finals draw, the contestant is responsible for the entry fees. - a. Waive, release and discharge from any and all liability for participant's death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to participation and his/her estate, the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials; and
- b. Indemnify and hold harmless the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials from and against any and all liabilities and claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of participant's participation or actions during this activity or event.

The undersigned further consents to and authorizes medical treatment to the participant, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident or illness during the event. The undersigned further understands that he/she is financially responsible for any such medical treatment.

This release and waiver shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.
