General 4-H Rodeo Rules & Regulations

The 4-H Rodeo Committee encourages both parents and contestants to fully read and understand the following rules which apply to all contestants and all events. **State 4-H Rodeo rules will be followed unless otherwise specified.** There will be no purse. It is not the desire of the Committee to injure the amateur status of any contestant in school or other sports. Points will be used to determine the All-Around winner. Selected will be an All-Around Senior Cowgirl and Cowboy; All-Around Junior Cowgirl and Cowboy. Detailed 4-H Rodeo Rules and Regulations are available at your County Extension Office. Here are specific rules:

1. Rodeo will be held at 10:00 AM on Sunday, August 5, 2012 (subject to time change depending on number of contestants).
2. **Liability**- The Glacial Lakes 4-H Rodeo Committee, Hills & Valley Riding Club, Roberts County 4-H Leaders Association, Sisseton Livestock Auction or their agents or their stock contractors will assume no liability for contestants, livestock, or spectator injuries, losses or damages. Every known precaution will be taken to promote safety. The rodeo arena will be worked prior to the show.
3. **Entries**- All entries must be received by Rodeo Secretary by [July 19, 2012](#). No late entries will be accepted. We shall require that the entry fee & proof of insurance accompany each entry. Payment can be negotiable check, cash, or money order to be made payable to Glacial Lakes 4-H Rodeo. Any contestants whose checks are returned due to non sufficient funds will not be allowed to compete unless cash is received by the time of registration. In no case will any entry be accepted that is not properly filled out and the parent's or guardian's **signature signed before a notary** or without adequate entry fees or without proof of insurance. A \$2.00 surcharge for 4-H Finals Award per contestant must be included with entry fee.
4. **Registration**- Contestants will get their number at the Rodeo Office, located at the Miles Nelson Memorial Arena starting at 8:00 AM on Sunday, August 5 (Ambassador Contestants will receive their number when they arrive and register on August 4). The rodeo performance starts promptly at 10:00 AM on Sunday. No additions to entries may be made at registration time. **Registration must be completed prior to the beginning of the performance.**
5. [Due to parking space constraints, all portable pens must be taken down by 8:00 AM on Sunday.](#)
6. Ambassador Contest will start at 5:00 PM and on Saturday, August 4 at the Miles Nelson Arena at Sisseton, South Dakota. Senior Ambassador winner of other 4-H Rodeos in 2012 is ineligible to compete in this event. All Ambassador Contestants must be entered in one other event.

8. All 4-H Rodeo rules will be enforced. We will be checking for wedges, gimmicks, or finger tucks. Any contestant found using these will automatically be disqualified. See rulebook on Bareback Bronc Riding.
9. **Judges decisions are final. Posted results are final. Contestants are subject to disqualification if either the contestant or a parent harrass the judge.**
10. Contestants must present entry card at gate for entry to the grounds.
11. **Contestants must wear their numbers at all times.**
12. **Contestants will be called for three times before they will be disqualified and passed by.** Be ready, unless obligated in the other arena. Large (North) arena takes precedence.
13. **All events will be decided by the flip of a coin. There will be no ties.**

**Parents or Guardians Agreement of Waiver of Liability,

Under South Dakota Law, equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities, pursuant to SDCL 42-11-1.

Said undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby represent that he/she is, in fact, acting in such capacity and agrees on behalf of the participant and his/her executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns to:

Waive, release and discharge from any and all liability for participant's death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to participant and his/her estate, the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials; and

Indemnify and hold harmless the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials from and against any and all liabilities and claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of participant's participation or actions during this activity or event.

This undersigned further consents to and authorizes medical treatment to the participant, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident or illness during this event. The undersigned further understands that he/she is financially responsible for any such medical treatment.

This release waiver shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.
