Under South Dakota Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities, pursuant to SDCL 42-11-1.

The undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby acknowledge that he/she is aware of the dangers involved in participating in 4-H Rodeo; and that rodeos are dangerous and will expose him/her to substantial and serious risk of property damage and/or personal injury or death.

Said undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby represent that he/she is, in fact, acting in such capacity and agrees on behalf of the participant and his/her executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns, to:

- a. Waive, release and discharge from any and all liability for participant's death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to participant and his/her estate, the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials; and
- b. Indemnify and hold harmless the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials from and against any and all liabilities and claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of participant's participation or actions during this activity or event.

The undersigned further consents to and authorizes medical treatment to the participant, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident or illness during this event. The undersigned further understands that he/she is financially responsible for any such medical treatment.

This release and waiver shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.

## HARDING COUNTY 4-H RODEO RULES

### KEEP RULES

\*\*\* NEW \*\*\*

Butte and Harding County 4-H Rodeos will be awarding a high point saddle. One saddle will be awarded to the 4-H member that accumulates the most points from both rodeos. The 4-H member must participate at both rodeos to be eligible for the saddle.

- The 4-H Rodeo Committee encourages parents and contestants to fully read the published rules, which apply, to all contestants and all events during this rodeo. We encourage you to read the State 4-H Rodeo Rules and Regulations (YD4H414 ). Contact your local extension office or download from the 4-H website.
- The Rodeo Office will be located at the south end of the concession stand and will be open from 7:00-8:30 a.m. All contestants **MUST** pick-up their numbers at the Rodeo Office before the contestants meeting, which will be held in front of the chutes at 8:45 am (contestant meeting is required). Contestants that do not check in and pick up their rodeo numbers prior to the contestants meeting will be disqualified from the rodeo. If unforeseen circumstances occur causing a delay, it will be the rodeo committee's decision to either deny or allow entry into the rodeo.
- Two arenas will be used. When contestants are involved in events that are in both arenas at the same time, the main arena will take precedence over the small arena. The small arena personnel will work with you when this happens. If you have a complaint, bring it to the crows nest, please do not hassle the workers. It is your responsibility to be ready when your stock is called. There will be no breaks.
- Contestants will have free admission. All other persons passing through the gate will be charged admission. Contestants passes will not be mailed, inform the gate attendants you are a contestant and your admissions will be free.
- Awards can be picked up at the south end of the concession stand starting at 1:00 p.m. A point system will be used to determine the All-Around Cowboy and Cowgirl in each division.
- A concession stand will be on the grounds near the south end of the arena.
- Results will be final after the rodeo is completed. Anyone questioning results or has a complaint must do so immediately.
- There will be no Ambassador Contest.
- Contestants ages 8 to 10 cannot participate in both the Jr. Jr. events and Jr. events. Must select one age group to participate in.
- Entry fees will accompany entry forms, in no case will fees be waived or refunded unless you have a medical release for your animal or yourself.
- In no case will any entry blank be accepted that is not properly filled out and the contestant, leader or extension educator, parents or guardians signature signed before a notary. Please use complete mailing address.
- You must have your own insurance, 4-H Rodeo Insurance, or eligible for Public Health Service care. All insurance information must be filled out completely. In no case will any entry blank be accepted that is not completely and properly filled out.
- Contestant must wear western hat or helmet in the arena at all times. Unless the hat rule is waived and hats will be checked at the gate.
- There will be no cash monies awarded and no jackpot.
- A protective vest and mouthpiece are mandatory equipment in all rough stock events.
- No Exhibition Runs.
- Contestants must wear their numbers at all times.
- NO LIQUOR WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS.
- CONTESTANTS CAN BE DISQUALIFIED FOR SWEARING OR ABUSIVE LANGUAGE.
- CONTESTANTS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED IF PARENTS HARASS THE JUDGE.
