

**Parents or Guardians Agreement of Waiver of Liability,
Indemnifications and Medical Release.**

Under South Dakota Law, equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities, pursuant to SDCL 42-11-1.

The undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby acknowledge that he/she is aware of the dangers involved in participating in 4-H Rodeo; and that rodeos are dangerous and will expose him/her to substantial and serious risk of property damage and/or personal injury or death.

Said undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby represent that he/she is, in fact, acting in such capacity and agrees on behalf of the participant and his/her executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns to:

- a. Waive, release and discharge from any and all liability for participant's death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to participant and his/her estate, the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials; and
- b. Indemnify and hold harmless the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials from and against any and all liabilities and claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of participant's participation or actions during this activity or event.

The undersigned further consents to and authorizes medical treatment to the participant, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and or illness during this event. The undersigned further understands that he/she is financially responsible for any such medical treatment.

This release waiver shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.

NURC 4-H RODEO

General 4-H Rodeo Rules and Regulations

1. STATE 4-H RODEO RULES and REGULATIONS will be followed.
2. The NURC 4-H Rodeos are TWO SEPARATE RODEOS with a chance to qualify for state in a contestant's respective event(s) each day.

State Qualifiers: Saturday – top four in each event qualify for finals
Sunday – Top four in each event qualify for finals
3. **REQUIRED** Contestants must include the completed PARENT/GUARDIAN WAIVER OF LIABILITY (Separate Sheet) If entering both rodeos, only one completed copy of the form is required.
4. No refunds will be given unless accompanied by a MED/VET release.
5. Entries must be postmarked by July 13, 2012.
6. Make Check or money order payable to NURC
7. Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. each day. Sunday only contestants need to register Sunday Morning.
8. Judges decisions are final and contestant's will be disqualified if parent's harass a judge or rodeo official. Contestant must see their event director for assistance with any problems on their run/ride. Event Directors will then take it to the Arena Director or judges.
9. Awards: Will be given: 1. Daily, 2. Two Go Average , 3. All around on two go (no average points
10. Two Go Average: Contestants must enter both days to be eligible for the TWO GO AVERAGE awards. The average will be figured on the total time on two go.
11. A contestant may be disqualified for swearing or abusive language.
12. Contestants must be in western attire when receiving awards.
13. Contestant surcharge is a onetime fee. This fee goes towards State 4-H Finals Awards.
14. Ambassador Contestants: Complete the Ambassador Contest Entry Form and mail to: Angie Derner, 16228 Red Top Road, New Underwood, SD 57761. **Send Entry Fee with Rodeo Entry Form.**

State Finals Entry

You MUST complete and have postmarked no later than August 1, 2012 the SD 4-H Finals Entry Form for ALL events where you qualified before August 1. Finals Entry Forms should be available at each of the regional rodeos and your county extension office.

For any event(s) where you qualified after August 1, 2012; you must complete the SD 4-H Finals Entry Form at that regional rodeo where you qualified for these events and leave forms and any fees due with the rodeo secretary of that particular rodeo. The regional rodeo secretary will forward the forms and dues to the State Rodeo Secretary. Only indicate the events in which you qualified at this regional rodeo on this entry form.
