We do hereby release the 4-H Rodeo committee and/or its agents and the stock contractor or his agent from any and all liability for damages whatsoever that may occur to our child and our child's horse or mount while competing in said show or while enroute to and from the rodeo arena. We give the local hospital or clinic and physicians or ambulance attendants permission to administer necessary treatment and release all of the above persons from liability.

PARENTS OR GUARDIANS AGREEMENT OF WAIVER OF LIABILITY, INDEMNIFICATION AND MEDICAL RELEASE

Under South Dakota Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities, pursuant to SDCL 42-11-1.

The undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby acknowledge that he/she is aware of the dangers involved in participating in 4-H Rodeo; and that rodeos are dangerous and will expose him/her to substantial and serious risk of property damage and/or personal injury or death.

Said undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby represent that he/she is, in fact, acting in such capacity and agrees on behalf of the participant and his/her executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns, to:

- a. waive, release and discharge from any and all liability for participant's death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to participant and his/her estate, the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials; and
- b. indemnify and hold harmless the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials from and against any and all liabilities and claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of participant's participation or actions during this activity or event.

The undersigned further consents to and authorizes medical treatment to the participant, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident or illness during this event. The undersigned further understands that he/she is financially responsible for any such medical treatment.

This release and waiver shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.

Southeastern South Dakota 4-H Rodeo Rules

1. **NO LATE ENTRIES!** Entries must be **postmarked** by **May 25, 2012**. Entry blanks will be returned if incomplete or missing the required fees. You will be notified if not accepted in an event. There will be **NO ENTRIES ALLOWED AT REGISTRATION**. No entries will be refunded. **Do NOT send cash.**
2. **Entries will be limited to the first 160 contestants!**
3. There will not be exhibition runs allowed.
4. **Scholarship applications** for graduating high school seniors, along with their completed rodeo entry forms, must be postmarked by **May 25, 2012**.
5. Start time is 10 a.m. on Saturday, June 16, 2012 at the **Crooks Rodeo Grounds in Crooks, South Dakota**. Contestants must pick up their numbers prior to the contestant meeting. The contestant's meeting will begin at 9:30 a.m.
6. State 4-H Rodeo Rules will be used. We encourage you to obtain and use the State 4-H Rodeo Rules and Regulations (SH 91,2006 edition) at your local County Extension Office. Some new rules have been added and it is the contestant's responsibility to learn the new rules.
7. Eligibility: The Southeastern South Dakota 4-H Rodeo is open to any bona fide 4-H member having either 4-H Rodeo Insurance or other adequate insurance coverage. Please be sure to fill out the waiver of liability, indemnification and medical release form.
8. If you enter team roping, **please** list the name of the header and heeler. There will be no choosing partners or changing partners after entry blanks are sent in.
9. A \$5.00 surcharge per contestant will be assessed. This is a required fee.
10. Contestants will be disqualified if the contestant or their parents harass the judge. All grievances must be directed to the arena director.
11. Contestants will be called for twice before they will be passed by. Be ready, unless obligated in the other arena. Small arena takes precedence.
12. No liquor will be permitted on the grounds.
13. Reminder: 4-H rules require vests and mouthpieces be worn for rough stock events.
14. Contestants must wear their number at all times. This includes when picking up prizes.
15. The hat rule will be enforced.
16. There will be no ties. Ties will be decided by a flip of the coin.
17. Contestants in the stock events must provide their own hazer or calf pusher. The Rodeo Committee will provide string, ribbons and rubber bands.
18. Event order and start times are subject to change.
19. Parking is limited. Please do not park in front of the elevator.

20. State Finals Rodeo Entry

State Finals paper work entry deadline is **MAY 1st**. Contestants are responsible to read and follow the General Information on Finals Entry Forms and the Ground Rules pertaining to the 4-H Finals Rodeo. All contestants qualifying for the 4-H Finals Rodeo (by finishing in the top 4 places at a Regional/County 4H Rodeo) are automatically entered. If a contestant does not wish to enter the finals or has event/events that they wish to not enter, then they will have to notify the Finals secretary by e-mailing sd4hfinals@hotmail.com by AUGUST 6th. If the contestant does not notify the secretary prior to the finals draw, the contestant is responsible for the entry fees.
