## Sioux Empire 4-H Rodeo Rules & Information

1. Entries must be postmarked by July 18, 2012.

Incomplete entries will be returned. There will be no entries allowed at registration. No refunds.

2. State 4-H Rodeo Rules will be used.

Rule books are available at http://sd4hrodeo.org/rules-regulations/

- Vests and mouthpieces are required to be worn for rough stock events
- Contestants must wear their number at all times.
- Hat rule will be enforced.
- Eligibility is open to any 4-H Member having either 4-H Rodeo Insurance or other adequate insurance coverage.
- 3. There will be no exhibition runs.
- **4.** Contestants will be called twice before moving to the next contestant unless contestant is obligated in other arena. Small arena takes precedence.
- **5.** All grievances must be directed toward the Arena Director. Harassment of Rodeo Officials by contestant or representative of contestant will result in disqualification of contestant.
- **6.** Ties will be broken by coin toss.
- 7. Contestant must provide own hazer or calf pusher.
- 8. Event order is subject to change.

## PARENTS OR GUARDIANS AGREEMENT OF WAIVER OF LIABILITY, INDEMNIFICATION AND MEDICAL RELEASE

Under South Dakota Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities, pursuant to SDCL 42-11-1.

The undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby acknowledge that he/she is aware of the dangers involved in participating in 4-H Rodeo; and that rodeos are dangerous and will expose him/her to substantial and serious risk of property damage and/or personal injury or death.

Said undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby represent that he/she is, in fact, acting in such capacity and agrees on behalf of the participant and his/her executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns, to:

- waive, release and discharge from any and all liability for participant's death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to participant and his/her estate, the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials; and
- indentify and hold harmless the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials from and against any and all liabilities and claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of participant's participation or actions during this activity or event.

The undersigned further consents to and authorizes medical treatment to the participant, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident or illness during this event. The undersigned further understands that he/she is financially responsible for any such medical treatment.

This release and waiver shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law. I,
