The undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby acknowledge that he/she is aware of the dangers involved in participating in 4-H Rodeo; and that rodeos are dangerous and will expose him/her to substantial and serious risk of property damage and/or personal injury or death.

Said undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby represent that he/she is, in fact, acting in such capacity and agrees on behalf of the participant and his/her executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns, to:

- a. waive, release and discharge from any and all liability for participant's death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to participant and his/her estate, the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials; and
- b. indemnify and hold harmless the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials from and against any and all liabilities and claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of participant's participation or actions during this activity or event.

The undersigned further consents to and authorizes medical treatment to the participant, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident or illness during this event. The undersigned further understands that he/she is financially responsible for any such medical treatment.

This release and waiver shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.

GENERAL RULES

The 4-H Rodeo Committee encourages both parents to fully read the published rules, which apply, to contestants and all events during this show. No deviations or exceptions can be made. We encourage you to obtain and read the State 4-H Rodeo Rules and Regulations (YD4H 414). These are available at your County Extension Office or the 4-H Website at <http://www.sd4hrodeo.org/>

Buckles will be awarded based on the two day average in each event, you must be entered both days to qualify. A point system will be used to determine the All-Around Champion Winners, these will also be figured on a two day average. All-Around Prize will be mailed.

After reading these general rules, we call your attention to the specific rules, which apply to individual events. The committee reserves the right to cancel any event due to lack of contestant participation.

1. Eligibility: The 4-H Rodeo is open to a 4-H member in good standing. Your current 4-H membership card MUST be presented to secure your contestant number.
2. Entries: **Entries will close on the 2nd of July, 2011.** We shall require that the fee must accompany each entry. This can be cash, check or money order, **made payable to the ZIEBACH COUNTY 4-H LEADERS ASSOCIATION.**
3. You will only be called twice per event. Have all equipment ready before the event.
4. There will be "No Video review" made available to the judges or arena personnel to assist in making a judgment call.
5. The decision of the judges, flagmen, timers and arbitration board who have been approved by the sponsoring rodeo board shall be final and no further protest by contestants will be allowed.
6. If using 1 horse in more than one age division, please inform the secretary at the cows nest of this.
7. All contestants must be in western attire when receiving awards.
8. **State Finals Rodeo Entry**
State Finals paper work entry deadline is May 1st. Contestants are responsible to read and follow the General Information on Finals Entry Forms and the Ground Rules pertaining to the 4-H Finals Rodeo. All contestants qualifying for the 4-H Finals Rodeo (by finishing in the top 4 places at a Regional/County 4H Rodeo) are automatically entered. If a contestant does not wish to enter the finals or has event/events that they wish to not enter, then they will have to notify the Finals secretary by e-mailing sd4hfinals@hotmail.com by AUGUST 8th. If the contestant does not notify the secretary prior to the finals draw, the contestant is responsible for the entry fees. BARREL RACING: WILL BE THE FIRST EVENT IN THE LARGE ARENA WITH ALL BARREL RACING BEING RUN IN THIS ORDER: SENIORS, JR. JR's & JR's

POLE BENDING: WILL BE THE FIRST EVENT IN THE SMALL ARENA WITH ALL POLES BEING RUN IN THIS ORDER: JR's, SENIORS, JR JR's

GATE ENTRY FEE: There will be a two day pass for the weekend if attending both days. The cost is \$7.00 for adults and \$5.00 for school age children. The one day will be \$5.00 adults and \$3.00 for school age children. You will be given a wrist bracelet for the weekend pass.
