



**CONTINUED FROM 2011:** Southwest Dakota 4-H Rodeo will be giving an additional prize for the all-around in each age division based on points from the Pennington County 4-H Rodeo (Wall June 14, 2014) and points earned at the Southwest Dakota 4-H Rodeo. Points will be given on a 10 point scale.

1. STATE 4-H Rodeo Rules and Regulations WILL be followed.
2. Entry Fees MUST accompany entry blank. IN NO CASE WILL AN ENTRY BLANK BE ACCEPTED THAT IS NOT PROPERLY FILLED OUT.
3. SURCHARGE.... A one-time surcharge of \$3.00 will be assessed to the JR and SR DIVISIONS to be used to furnish awards at the STATE 4-H FINALS RODEO.
4. REGISTRATION .... Contestants must check in at Secretary Office (next to the small arena) by 9:30 AM.
5. NUMBERS .... Contestants must wear their numbers at all times.
6. CONTESTANT MEETING .... All contestants shall meet at the large arena gate at 9:45 AM, for a MANDATORY contestant meeting.
7. EVENTS.... Each contestant will be called twice for an event. IF OBLIGATED in both arenas the LARGE ARENA takes PRECEDENCE. PLEASE.... Inform the event director of this happens.
8. PROBLEMS..... If a problem arises .... Go to the EVENT DIRECTOR and they will go to the ARENA DIRECTOR.
9. CAN NOT CHANGE THE ORDER OF RUN....without the ARENA DIRECTOR'S APPROVAL.
10. AMBASSADOR CONTEST will begin at 7:00 am.

If the contestant does not notify the secretary prior to the finals draw, the contestant is responsible for the entry fees. **PARENTS OR GUARDIANS AGREEMENT OF WAIVER OF LIABILITY, INDEMNIFICATION  
AND MEDICAL RELEASE**

Under South Dakota Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities, pursuant to SDCL 42-11-1.

The undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby acknowledge that he/she is aware of the dangers involved in participating in 4-H Rodeo; and that rodeos are dangerous and will expose him/her to substantial and serious risk of property damage and/or personal injury or death.

Said undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby represent that he/she is, in fact, acting in such capacity and agrees on behalf of the participant and his/her executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns, to:

- a. waive, release and discharge from any and all liability for participant's death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to participant and his/her estate, the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials; and
- b. indemnify and hold harmless the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents, employees, 4-H volunteers, stock contractors, arena owners and arena officials from and against any and all liabilities and claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of participant's participation or actions during this activity or event.

The undersigned further consents to and authorizes medical treatment to the participant, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident or illness during this event. The undersigned further understands that he/she is financially responsible for any such medical treatment.

This release and waiver shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.
