The 4-H Rodeo Committee encourages parents and contestants to fully read the published rules that apply to all events during this show. No deviations or exceptions can be made. We encourage you to read the State 4-H Rodeo Rules and Regulations (4-H 175). These are available at your County Extension Office.

- First place buckles will be awarded in each event. A point system will be used to determine the All-Around Cowboy and Cowgirl in each event, and prizes will be awarded to these.
- Entry fees will accompany entry blanks. In no case will fees be waived or refunded.
- IN NO CASE WILL ANY ENTRY BE ACCEPTED THAT IS NOT PROPERLY FILLED OUT AND THE CONTESTANT, LEADER OR COUNTY AGENT, PARENTS OR GUARDIANS SIGNATURE SIGNED BEFORE A NOTARY. <u>PLEASE USE COMPLETE MAILING ADDRESS</u> <u>AND TELEPHONE NUMBER IN CASE WE NEED TO CONTACT YOU.</u>
- CONTESTANTS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED IF A PARENT HARASSES THE JUDGE!
- You must have an insurance card or be listed with the State as having equivalent insurance.
- WE reserve the right to limit the number of contestants in any event.
- There will no cash monies awarded and no jackpot.
- Contestants must wear their numbers at all times.
- The rodeo will begin at 8:00 a.m.

State Finals Rodeo Entry

State Finals paper work entry deadline is May 1st.
