## **KEEP RULES**

## HARDING COUNTY 4-H RODEO RULES

- The 4-H Rodeo Committee encourages parents and contestants to fully read the published rules, which apply, to all contestants and all events during this rodeo. We encourage you to read the current State 4-H Rodeo Rules and Regulations. Contact your local extension office or download from the 4-H website.
- Social distancing is highly encouraged, the CDC recommends to stay 6 feet apart, if you are sick please stay home.
- The Rodeo Office will be located under the crows nest at the Tipperary Arena and will be open from 7:00-8:30 a.m. All contestants must attend the contestants meeting which will be held in front of the chutes at 8:45 am (contestant meeting is required). If unforeseen circumstances occur causing a delay, it will be the rodeo committee's decision to either deny or allow entry into the rodeo.
- Two arenas will be used. When contestants are involved in events that are in both arenas at the same time, the main arena will take precedence over the small arena. The small arena personnel will work with you when this happens. If you have a complaint, bring it to the crows nest, please do not hassle the workers. It is your responsibility to be ready when your name is called. There will be no breaks.
- Contestants will have free admission. Contestants MUST present their official SD 4-H Back Numbers to the ticket takers to receive free admission to the rodeo. All other persons passing through the gate will be charged admission.
- Event placement will be announced throughout the day and prizes will be available to pickup shortly after each announcement. Awards can be picked up at the south end of the concession stand. A point system will be used to determine the All-Around Cowboy and Cowgirl in each division. Buckles will be given to first place winners and money to 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> places.
- A concession stand will be on the grounds near the south end of the arena.
- Results will be final after the rodeo is completed. Anyone questioning results or has a complaint must do so immediately.
- There will be no Ambassador Contest.
- Contestants ages 8 to 10 cannot participate in both the Jr. Jr. events and Jr. events. 4-Hers must select only one age group to participate in.
- Entry fees will accompany entry forms; in no case will fees be waived or refunded unless you have a medical release for your animal or yourself.
- In no case will any entry blank be accepted that is not properly filled out and complete. Please use complete mailing
- You must have your own insurance, 4-H Rodeo Insurance, or eligible for Public Health Service care.
- Contestant must wear western hat or helmet in the arena at all times, unless the hat rule is waived in which case hats will be checked at the gate.
- A protective vest and mouthpiece are mandatory equipment in all rough stock events.
- No Exhibition Runs.
- Contestants must wear their numbers at all times.
- NO LIQUOR WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS.
- CONTESTANTS CAN BE DISQUALIFIED FOR SWEARING OR ABUSIVE LANGUAGE.
- CONTESTANTS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED IF PARENTS HARASS THE JUDGE.
