Entries must be **POSTMARKED** on or before **July 10 (no late entries)**.

REGISTRATION- 7:00 TO 8:30 a.m.

Contestant must wear their numbers in a visible spot while competing.

Contestant meeting at **8:30 a.m.** in the large arena.

Rodeo starts at **9:00 a.m.**

Contestants will be called 3 times before they are disqualified and passed by. Order of events is subject to change.

If a contestant is entered in a Jr.Jr. event they can not enter a Junior event. Ex: If they enter Jr.Jr. barrels, they can not enter Jr. poles. Ex: Junior contestants cannot enter into senior events.

COVID-19 Guidelines

We are asking that all spectators and contestants follow the guidelines:

If you are not comfortable attending the event, **PLEASE** do not come!

If you are not feeling well or are feeling sick, we ask that you **DO NOT** attend the rodeo.

PLEASE allow distancing when parking.

A charge of \$5.00 is being added as a separate line item on each entry form for the gate entrance fee. This will eliminate the need for gate personnel to collect money upon entrance to the facility.

Check in will be done when entering facility. Please remain in your vehicle, and tell the check-in personnel the names of contestants checking in, as well as any events they are drawing out of.

A food vendor truck will be on-site to provide food, rather than the traditional youth-run concession stand. Please practice social distancing while ordering/waiting for food.

Face masks are recommended in all areas and will be provided upon request at the entrance gate. Face masks are required in the arena zone unless state standards are relaxed by event date. Contestants can pull down masks while performing.

Please limit attendees to immediate family of contestants.

Practice social distancing at all times and in the seating areas, as per CDC recommendations

Contestants, **DO NOT** congregate by any of the arena gates, or on the Bucking Chutes.

For the flag race, multiple sets of flags will be rotated and sanitized between use.

An appropriate number of volunteers will be staffed according to the number of contestants entered. Volunteers should remain in their designated role/location throughout the day.

Rough Stock and Timed Event will be allowed **NO MORE** than 2 helpers.

Hand sanitizing stations will be distributed throughout the area.

Bathrooms and surfaces will be sanitized on a scheduled basis.

The rodeo committee will have the right to ask anyone to leave the grounds that is not complying with any of the guidelines put into place.

Thank you for your patience and understanding. If you are not comfortable, PLEASE do not attend.

COVID-19 RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of the above-named member ("Member") being allowed to participate and compete in the Pennington County 4-H Rodeo on July 31, 2020 in Wall, SD, we, the Member, and the undersigned parent(s) or legal guardian of the Member, on behalf of the Member, and for ourselves, our personal representatives, heirs, spouse, parents, siblings, and children, do hereby:

1. RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the Pennington County 4-H Rodeo, South Dakota 4-H Rodeo, SDSU, host facility owners, any rodeo committee, any stock contractor, any rodeo or event sponsors, or any other entity associated with the Pennington County 4-H Rodeo, and each of them and their officers, directors, trustees, managers, agents and employees (all of whom are collectively referred to herein as "Releasees") from any and all liability to the Member, the undersigned, and their personal representatives, assigns, heirs, parents, legal guardians, siblings, and children, and any claims or demands therefore, on account of the Member's or the undersigned's injury, illness, disease or death from the COVID-19 coronavirus, which occurs as a result of the Member's or any of the undersigned's entrance onto the Pennington County 4-H Rodeo at the Wall, SD rodeo arena and/or participation as a contestant, assistant, official or otherwise in any rodeo event, whether such injury, sickness, disease or death is caused by the negligence or other wrongful conduct of, strict liability or otherwise by, one or more of the Releasees or any contestants, spectators or other individuals at the Wall, SD rodeo arena.
2. AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASEES and each of them from any liability, damage or loss (including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees and other defense costs) one or more of them may suffer or incur arising out of or related to the Member's or any of the undersigned's entry onto the Pennington County 4-H Rodeo at the Wall, SD rodeo arena and/or participation in any rodeo events, whether such claim is based on one or more of the Releasees' negligence, breach of contract or warranty, strict liability or other legal theory.
3. UNDERSTAND that Member's and the undersigned's entry onto the grounds of the Pennington County 4-H Rodeo at the Wall, SD rodeo arena and/or participation in rodeo events during the COVID-19 pandemic contains DANGER AND RISK OF ILLNESS, DISEASE, INJURY OR DEATH TO MEMBER and the undersigned, that COVID-19 is highly contagious, and that there is INHERENT DANGER in COVID-19 which the Member and each of the undersigned appreciate and voluntarily assume because we choose to do so. WE EACH VOLUNTARILY ELECT TO ASSUME AND ACCEPT ALL RISKS inherent in COVID-19.
4. We each agree to comply with all federal, state and local laws and regulations and all security policies and procedures of the Pennington County 4-H Rodeo relating to COVID-19. We each understand that the Member may be denied entrance to the Pennington County 4-H Rodeo and not allowed to participate or continue to participate in the rodeo based on medical check-in requirements and continuing medical requirements during the duration of the rodeo. The undersigned agree that in the event any portion of this document is held to be invalid, the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect to the greatest extent possible under applicable law. The parents or guardian of the Member agree that by signing below they are in addition to binding themselves, binding the Member to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law.

WE HAVE READ THIS RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT WE HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE, OR GUARANTEE BEING MADE, AND INTEND THIS TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY APPLICABLE LAW.
