The 4-H Rodeo Committee encourages parents and contestants to fully read the published rules, which apply, to all contestants and all events during this show. No deviations or exceptions can be made. We encourage you to read the State 4-H Rodeo Rules and Regulations (01-4000-2015 Edition and any revisions).

First place buckles, second place hooded sweat-shirts, third place \$20.00, and fourth place \$15.00 will be awarded in each event. A point system will be used to determine the All-Around Cowboy and Cowgirl in each division, and All-Around buckles will be awarded to these.

There will be no Ambassador Contest.

Entry fees must accompany entry blank; in no case will fees be waived or refunded.

IN NO CASE WILL ANY ENTRY BLANK BE ACCEPTED THAT IS NOT PROPERLY FILLED OUT AND THE CONTESTANT & PARENTS OR GUARDIANS SIGNATURE SIGNED. PLEASE USE COMPLETE MAILING ADDRESS. IT WILL BE NEEDED IF YOU QUALIFY FOR STATE. STATE 4H RODEO WEBSITE IS: www.sd4hrodeo.org

Contestants must pick up their number and register before their event begins. The rodeo will begin at 10:00 AM MT sharp on May 24th at the Timber Lake Arena. We will be starting the Rodeo with two arenas. The first events will be all of the Pole Bending & Goat Tying in south arena and all of the Breakaway Roping, Ribbon Roping, Calf Roping & Flag Race in the north arena.

You will be called only twice for an event. Be ready.

Contestants will pay when they come through the gate.

NO LIQUOR WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS.

CONTESTANTS CAN BE DISQUALIFIED FOR SWEARING OR ABUSIVE LANGUAGE.
