Sioux Empire Youth Rodeo Rules & Information

1. Entries must be postmarked by **May 11, 2024**.

Incomplete entries will be returned. There will be no entries allowed at registration. No refunds.

2. State 4-H Rodeo Rules will be used.

Rule books are available at <http://sd4hrodeo.org/rules-regulations/>

- Vests and mouthpieces are required to be worn for rough stock events.
- Contestants must wear their number at all times.
- Hat rule will be enforced.

3. There will be no exhibition runs.

4. Contestants will be called three times before moving to the next contestant unless the contestant is obligated in the other arena.

5. All grievances must be directed towards the Arena Director. Harassment of Rodeo Officials by contestant or representative of contestant will result in disqualification of contestant.

6. Ties will be broken by coin toss.

7. Contestants must provide their own hazer or calf pusher.

8. Event order is subject to change.
