BLUNT 4-H RODEO GROUND RULES

Lariat Riding Club Arena Blunt, South Dakota July 18 & 19, 2020



- 1. State 4-H Rodeo Rules will be used. We encourage you to obtain and use the State 4-H Rodeo Rules and Regulations SH-91 at your local County Extension Office. Some new rules have been added and it is contestant's responsibility to learn the new rules.
- 2. Rodeo will begin at 9:30 am on both days. Contestants remember your back numbers. If you don't have your back number and one needs to be made for you it will cost \$5.00.
- 3. First through fourth place awards will be awarded in each event. A point system will be used to determine the All-Around Champion winners. Awards will be given to the All-Around Cowboy and Cowgirl in each division.
- 4. ALL AROUND SADDLES will be awarded in each division to the contestants with the most average points on both Saturday and Sunday. Contestants must compete both days to be eligible for the saddle.
- 5. Eligibility: The Blunt 4-H Rodeo is open to any bonafide 4-H member having either 4-H Rodeo insurance or other adequate insurance coverage.
- 6. If you enter team roping, **you must list** the name of the header and heeler. Please be sure your partner is entered in the rodeo.
- 7. A \$5.00 surcharge/contestant/day will be assessed. This is a required fee. No Gate Charge.
- 8. A \$2.00/per program fee will be charged.
- 9. Contestants will be disqualified if parents harass the judge.
- 10. Contestants will be called for twice before they will be passed by. Be ready, unless obligated in the other arena. Main arena takes precedence.
- 11. No liquor will be permitted on the grounds.
- 12. Reminder: 4-H rules require vests and mouthpieces are worn for rough stock events.
- 13. If you have any questions, please call Jackie Mercer 605-222-2316 after 6 p.m.
- 14. <u>NO LATE ENTRIES</u>. Entry blanks will be returned if not completed fully and have money enclosed. <u>NO ENTRIES WILL BE REFUNDED WITHOUT A DOCTOR'S OR VET RELEASE</u>.
- 15. State Finals Entry: Contestants are responsible to read and follow the General Information on Finals Entry Forms and the Ground Rules pertaining to the 4-H Finals Rodeo. All contestants qualifying for the 4-H Finals Rodeo (by finishing in the top 4 places at a Regional/County 4-H Rodeo) are automatically entered. NOTE: If a contestant has qualified in the top four at a Regional Rodeo and does not wish to enter the Finals or has event/events that they do not wish to enter, they must notify the SD 4-H Finals secretary via emailing 4HFinalsSecretary@gmail.com by AUGUST 1st. Contestants who fail to notify the SD 4-H Finals secretary of events they do not wish to participate in prior to the draw being posted, are responsible for paying the entry fees for those events. COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR SPECTATORS AND CONTESTANTS

The check in rule will be waived for the rodeo.

In the flag race either gloves will be worn or the flag will be sanitized after each run.

We will encourage 1 helper per contestant for all the events.

We encourage contestants NOT to congregate by any of the arena gates or on the bucking chutes.

We encourage parents/guardians to bring their own lawn chairs and practice social distancing. We do have available multiple sets of bleaches in both arenas for seating at a social distance. We encourage families to sit together.

For sanitation purposes masks, gloves and hand sanitizer will be made available throughout the rodeo grounds. We recommend that masks be worn in the arena zone. Members can pull down masks while performing.

We ask that all spectators and contestants follow the COVID 19 guidelines. We encourage social distancing and good hygiene practice. If you are sick or feeling unwell you will be asked to leave. If you are not comfortable attending the event, please do not come.
